<p>SUSPENSION AND BRAKE SYSTEMS</p> <p>Knowledge of suspension and brake systems sufficient to perform maintenance, make repairs, install replacement parts, or adjust the systems when needed.</p>	13.0%
<p>COOLING SYSTEMS</p> <p>Knowledge of cooling systems sufficient to perform maintenance, repairs, adjust the system, or install replacement parts when needed.</p>	6.0%

<p>INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, TESTING, AND REPAIR OF PORTABLE EQUIPMENT</p> <p>Knowledge of fire apparatus sufficient to perform inspection, maintenance, testing, and repair, including rotary gear, pumps, water delivery systems, foam systems, aerial ladders, and hydraulic systems.</p>	13.0%
<p>MANAGING EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY/SUPPLIES</p> <p>Knowledge of the management and maintenance of equipment, property, and supplies, including verifying that equipment is tested and meets applicable standards.</p>	6.0%
